The Spanish capital and its region are among the most visited by foreigners for its museums, its architectural heritage and its nightlife. Madrid is the rallying point for numerous artists, such as painters, Flamenco dancers or bull fighters, and it is that dynamic atmosphere that we want you to discover and enjoy during those three days.

Day 1- Madrid : a bird's eye view

Along with an official tour guide, the group will start their city-break with a guided tour of the Spanish capital.

- Lunchtime: Arrival at the airport and bus transfer to the city centre. Guided tour of Madrid: Palacio Real (Madrid castle, from the outside), Paseo de la Castellana, Biblioteca Nacional (National Library), Cibeles, Puerta de Alcalá (see picture), Gran Vía, Plaza de España with the Don Quijote monument and the famous Puerta del Sol.



- Dinner and night at a 3* hotel in Madrid

Day 2- Between city and countryside

A tour guide will be escorting the group for the day.

- Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. The group will then make its way toward the province of **Chinchón**, one of Spain's most picturesque towns. The group will then have the opportunity to attend a bullfighter training in **Aranjuez**.

- Typical lunch in **Aranjuez**

- Afternoon: back in **Madrid**, the group will have the opportunity to enjoy some free time to walk around town, buy souvenirs, etc...

- Dinner and night at a 3* hotel in Madrid

- **Flamenco** show (optional).



Day 3- Museum day

Along with an official guide and after enjoying a typical Spanish breakfast, the group will visit one of the city's many museums before going back to the airport.

- Morning: Typical Spanish breakfast of "chocolate con churros" in Madrid city-centre. The group will then go to either the Prado Museum or the Reina Sofia museum, to admire masterpieces such as Picasso's *Guernica*.

- Bus transfer to the airport
