DAY 1 - MADRID: REINA SOFIA MUSEUM OR PRADO MUSEUM AND VISITTING THE HISTORICAL MADRID



Madrid - Puerta del Sol

Madrid is a very cosmopolitan city, a mix of tradition and modernity. We will discover one of Europe's oldest historical city-centre, symbol of its importance in history.

Madrid is shaped with new infrastructures, required for a capital to play its role as an administrative, economic and cultural centre.

We will visit the Reina Sofia Museum, dedicated to modern and contemporary Spanish art, where we will admire the famous Picasso painting "Guernica". Another alternative could be the Prado Museum, considered to be one of the most important in the world. The Museum displays masterpieces from the XIV to the XIX century by Velazquez, Goya, Bosch or El Greco.

After the visit, we suggest you take a walk in the Retiro Park, old soothing place of the Spanish Kings.

Later, we will visit at our own pace the historical quarter of Madrid: you will see the impressive Plaza Mayor, symbol of the city's former glory during the XVI and XVII century, the Plaza Cibeles, Puerta de Alcala, Gran Via, Puerta del Sol and the Cathedral de Almudena.

DAY 2 – MADRID: BULLFIGHTING AND VISIT TO THE ESCORIAL



El Escorial

We will discover the bullfighting culture by visiting the Las Ventas bullring and its museum, with the opportunity to look at a series of paintings by Goya related to the bullfighting world, as well as a display of objects commonly found in the bullfighting way of life.

In the afternoon we will visit the Escorial, former residence of the King of Spain and listed on the UNESCO's World Heritage Site list. It is an impressive complex which includes a Palace and a monastery in which you can find the Museum of Architecture and Painting and a library.

DAY 3 – MADRID: ROYAL PALACE, MUSEUM OF THE AMERICAS AND BERNABEU STADIUM



Madrid – Palacio Real

We will visit the Royal Palace, built upon and old Moorish Alcazar and now residence of the King of Spain. We will then stop by the Museum of the Americas to discover the history and culture of the Americas from the pre-Columbian era to our days. It displays works by South American artists from Puerto Rico and the United States.

We will end the day at the Real Madrid Stadium, the Santiago Bernabeu.
